We require Skilled Site Operatives to install, maintain, service, inspect and repair our range of screens and screenings handling plant on installations around the UK.

The **key duties** of the post are as follows;

- Loading/unloading of vehicles
- Removal/Installation, testing and commissioning, inspection, problem solving, maintenance and breakdown repair of equipment on Customers' sites
- Inspections and examination of equipment in need of repair to determine requirements and reporting back to enable quotations to be submitted
- Assembly of screens and other equipment in the workshop
- Must be able to work to reasonable times and quality standards
- Supervision of other site work employees providing assistance (i.e.: apprentice, labourer or semi-skilled staff)
- Representing the Company and acting in its best interests at all times, ensuring not to bring the Company into disrepute
